Purposes for processing personal data, as well as the legal basis for the processing

If your personal data is processed for the purpose of safeguarding the legitimate interests of the responsible party according to art. 6 para. 1 lit. f of the GDPR, then these legitimate interests shall consist of permanently analyzing and improving the online presence, as well as optimizing usability. If you transmit data to us via our online forms, the personal data which you provide shall be processed to meet the respective purpose.

If you have not objected to tracking by Google Analytics and the use of cookies, we analyze the use of our website. This includes

- pages accessed,
- bounce rate and
- time spent on the respective page.

The identity of the users is not known to us and we do not take any measures to obtain corresponding information elsewhere. We analyze this technical data anonymously and for statistical purposes only, in order to constantly optimize our website and make it even more attractive. This anonymous data is stored separately from personal information on secure systems. Your personal data and your privacy are therefore protected at all times.

Recipients of your personal data

Your personal data shall only be passed on to third parties with your consent or if there is a legal justification for consent. Transmission of your personal data to state institutions and authorities who are entitled to receive such information shall only take place within the framework of the relevant legislation, or if we are obligated to do so due to a judicial decision. Our employees are obligated to confidentiality and compliance with the provisions of data protection legislation.

Use of cookies

This website uses so-called cookies. These are small text files which are sent to your browser from our web server and stored on your computer's hard disk. No personal data is stored during this process. Instead, an individual pseudonym is used. This information is used, for example, to re-recognize you during navigation to our websites and to make navigation easier for you.

You can adjust the settings of your browser to inform you when cookies are placed. In this way, the use of cookies shall be transparent. Alternatively, you can also view this website without cookies. Your security

We take technical and organizational measures to protect your data against unauthorized access, loss, manipulation and destruction. Our security measures are constantly being updated in accordance with technological development. All communication between your end device and our servers is encrypted. This applies both for downloading documents or information offered via our website, as well as for any information, which you have provided us with via the contact form or application form.

Storage Duration

The personal data which you provide to us is automatically deleted if the purposes for processing are no longer applicable. More specifically, the following storage periods shall apply:

Technical data and records for safeguarding website operation.	6 months
Content, which we receive from you.	The storage periods for this content are based upon the type of information transmitted and the respectively applicable statutory retention periods. If, within the framework of the rights of the persons affected, you request deletion at an earlier point in time, then the data shall immediately be deleted upon your request.

Rights of the persons affected

You have a right to access information about your stored personal data at any time. According to articles 16 to 20 of the GDPR, you also have the right to the correction of inaccurate data, the right to the deletion of your personal data, the right to restrict the processing of your personal data, as well as the right to data portability.

You are entitled to revoke any consent you have given at any time. The revocation shall apply with immediate effect for the future. The revocation shall not affect the lawfulness of the processing carried out on the basis of consent up to the time of revocation.

Pursuant to Art. 21 para. 1 GDPR you have the right to object at any time to the processing of your personal data in cases covered under Art. 6 para. 1 lit. f) GDPR at the above address for reasons arising from your particular situation. If you file an objection, we will no longer process your personal data unless we can prove compelling reasons for processing worthy of protection that outweigh your interests, rights and freedoms, or the processing serves the assertion, exercise or defense of legal claims.

Right to complain

If you are of the opinion that the processing of your personal data constitutes a violation of the GDPR, then you have the right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority.

Provision of your personal data

Personal data is information about your identity. For example, this includes details such as name, postal address, and telephone number or even email address. It is not necessary to disclose any personal data in order to be able to use this website. In certain cases, we do, however, require your name and address, as well as other details, in order to be able to provide you with the desired services.
